Evaluation Criteria and Point system for Scholarship Applications

The following point system will be applied for each application.

Membership	1 point for each year
Church Involvement	20
Community Involvement	10
Expressed Need	20
Relationship with Christ Statement	20
First time receiving academic scholarship	5
First time receiving any monetary aid from FPCSA	5
